Airai Bai Meetinghouse . The bai, a Palauan name for meetinghouse, is located on a stone platform in the center of Airai village where the previous bails stood in the past. The assembly hall is 79 by 20 feet (22 meters by 6 meters), and about 39 feet high (11.4 meters). The roof is woven from nipa leaves and tropical woods are used across the floors and walls.
